Carl's Dye-a-logue

Recipes can be funny things. Sometimes they call for definitive measures of ingredients (1 cup flour, 1/4 tsp. vanilla, etc.) and other times they call for subjective measures of ingredients (a dash of salt...your "dash" and my "dash" may not be the same amount after all, and this time my dash may be one amount and next time my dash may be more or less the first time).

Yet, for all the various amounts, the recipe, if followed, will always produce a similar looking end result. If we are following the same recipe we should end up with the same thing...no matter if my "dash" of salt was more or less than your "dash."

On the outside, they look pretty much the same...but a difference may be found in the taste. If your dash of salt was next to nothing, but my dash of salt was next to a teaspoon, the inside of our dishes will taste very different.

Words can have an incredible amount of influence in our lives and in the lives of others. We may think that what we said is just a "dash of salt" and really next to nothing. However the person we spoke those words to may have not taken them so lightly.

James describes the tongue as, "...a fire, a world of evil..." (James 3:6) and "...a restless evil, full of deadly poison" (James 3:8).

We may be joking. We may be playing a prank on someone. We may be the furthest thing from serious. But if we are talking to the wrong person or at the wrong time, and/or they take us seriously, much harm can result from it.

Twice the Bible tells us, "A little yeast works through the whole batch of dough" (1 Corinthians 5:6, Galatians 5:9). Words can be just like yeast. Just a single word, perhaps spoken in jest, can really hurt a person.

So what influence are your words having on others? Are your words building others up? Or are your words tearing others down? Even if the influence is unintentional, it can be devastating.

More than just hurting the other person, though, when we use our words to hurt others, we hurt God as well.
