**Carl's Dye-a-logue**

I have a Baptist preacher friend in Bonham who regularly posts some pretty funny stuff on his Facebook page. Following the most recent actions of the group ISIS, he posted a much more serious post on his Facebook wall:  
 "So 21 middle east Christians get their heads cut off for identifying with Christ... And American Christians can't even show up for church..."

This really struck a cord with me. Don't misunderstand, there are times when missing church services is unavoidable (when you are sick, for example...especially if you are contagious). But there are times when we don't attend just because, well, we just don't feel like going to church.

Maybe it is a sporting event (either live that we have tickets to or on the TV that just won't be the same if we record it; or either its a professional event or a game for our kids or grandkids, etc.).

Maybe we just have "something better to do" in our own minds. Maybe since we went on Sunday morning for an hour, we feel Sunday night and Wednesday night are completely optional (never mind Bible class on Sunday morning...I can't get up that early after "enjoying" my Saturday night!).

Maybe we just feel like all God demands or has a right to expect of us is the bare minimum. Maybe "bare minimum" is all we are willing to give?

What about those 21 who were beheaded for their faith? Did they give the bare minimum?

What about the apostles who suffered in unspeakable ways for their testimony about Christ...and passing it on to us? Did they give the bare minimum?

What about God, "...who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him up for us all..." (Romans 8:32)? Did HE give the bare minimum?

If you were on an athletic team, and gave the bare minimum, what would the coach say?

If you are a Christian and give minimum effort, what will Jesus say (see Matthew 7:21-23).
