The old man said, "I can't do that! The wind spread them and I won't know where to find them."

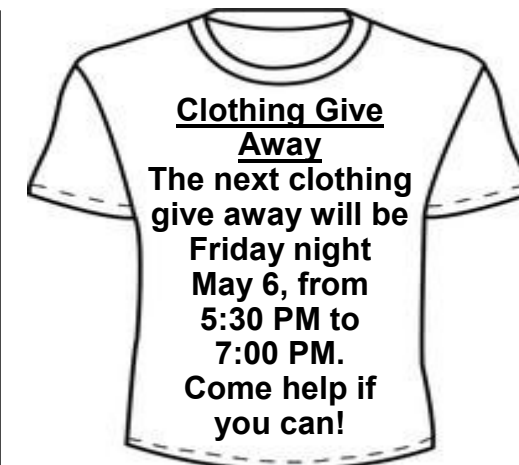
