⁴ You know the way to the place where I am going."

Jesus is preparing a place for us...and it is so much better than what we have here that there is really no way to describe it. Paul tells us, though, in Philippians 1:23, of his desire to "...depart and be with Christ, which is better by far..."

So don't be deceived by the "laughing gas" the world (and Satan, for that matter) wants you to be content with while on earth. It may seem pretty good for now...but remember, "The world and its desires pass away..." (1 John 2:17).
