My Family Eye Care (Dr. Vaughan) on State Line Road.

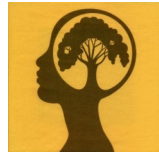
Every one needs a coat in the kind of weather we will have in the coming weeks. If you need someone to pick up coat's, please call the church office and we will make the necessary arrangements.

As they are on their way to show themselves to the priest, they are cleansed of the "various disease of the skin" was affecting them.

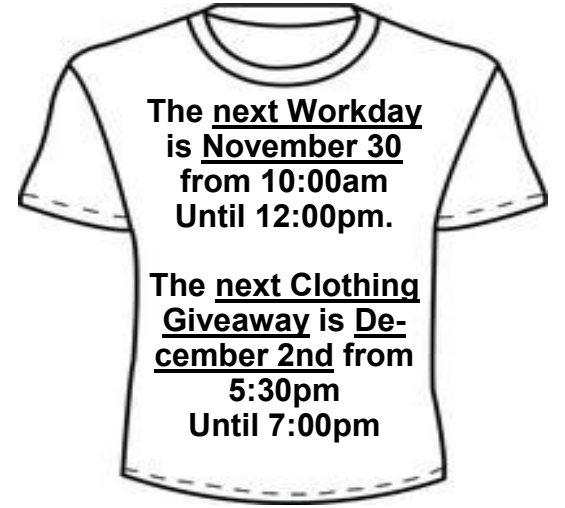
End of the Month Singing
