As Christians, though, we can either allow our culture to mold and shape us or we can mold and shape culture.

There are some who feel the Bible is out of touch with our modern, advanced culture and society. They believe certain passages can be ignored because, well, "In the 1st Century they were not as intelligent as we are today..." or something like that.

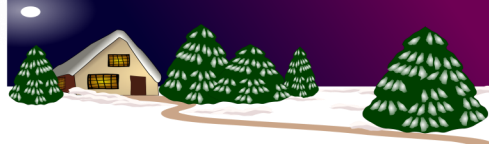

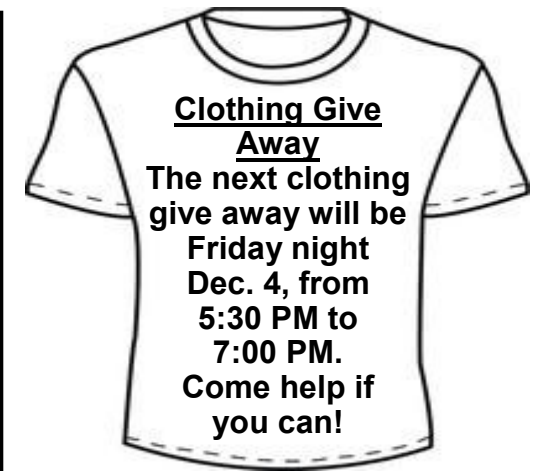
"THE BASKET" for "SARAH'S KIDS"
